THEATRE OF STEFAN JARACZ

THE OBJECT, WHICH WAS CREATED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE XX CENTURY, WAS AT FIRST NUSFELD'S HOUSE, LATER IT BELONGED TO CALEL PERECHODNIK. BEFORE THE WAR THE BUILDING WAS REBUILT AND THERE WAS A CINEMA „ZNICZ”. NOW THERE IS A THEATRE AND ‘OAZA’ CINEMA HERE.





CINEMA 'PROMYK'

THE CINEMA WAS OPENED AFTER
THE SECOND WORLD WAR AND IT
WAS NAMED 'PROMYK'. IT
OPERATED UNTIL 1990s. CURRENTLY,
THE FILMS ARE SHOWN AT THE
'OAZA' CINEMA, WHICH IS LOCATED
IN THE MUNICIPAL THEATRE
BUILDING.





RAILWAY WATER TOWER

A THREE-STORY WATER TOWER
WITH A HEIGHT OF 21 METRES WAS
BUILT AT THE END OF THE 19TH
CENTURY NEAR THE RAILWAY
STATION. IT WAS MODERNIZED IN
1910. CURRENTLY IT IS A VACANT
PROPERTY.





TOWN HALL

IT WAS BUILT IN 1880 FOR THE ENGINEER STANISŁAW SIERKOWSKI. THEN, IN 1916 WHEN OTWOCK WAS GRANTED TOWN RIGHTS, THE BUILDING WAS BOUGHT BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND USED AS A TOWN HALL. IT IS SAID TO BE ONE OF THE MOST RECOGNIZABLE LANDMARKS OF OTWOCK BECAUSE OF ITS CLOCK TOWER AND AN IMPRESSIVE TERRACE.





RAILWAY STATION

THE STATION, BUILT IN THE LATE
1980S AND WAS THE CENTRE OF
SOCIAL LIFE.

ALTHOUGH THE BUILDING IS NOT
INCLUDED IN THE REGISTER OF
MONUMENTS, IT IS WORTH VISITING
TO ADMIRE THE WONDERFUL
WOODEN VAULT.





VILLA JULIA

IT WAS BUILD AROUND 1890. IN 1905
IT BECAME AN INHALATORY AND
THEN A POST AND TELEGRAPH
OFFICE. AFTER WWII AND UNTIL
THE 1980s IT WAS A COUNCIL FLAT.
TODAY, THIS BEAUTIFUL BUILDING
IS IN PRIVATE HANDS AND IS
WAITING TO BE SUBJECTED TO
RECONSTRUCTION





JABŁONOWSKA NARROW-GAUGE RAILWAY STATION (1914)

IT WAS BUILT IN 1914. CURRENTLY,
THERE IS NO TRACE OF THE
FORMER TRACK, BUT THE STATION
BUILDING AT WAWERSKA STREET
HAS EXISTED UNCHANGED SINCE
ITS CONSTRUCTION.





THE MONUMENT OF 'ISKRA'

THE MONUMENT COMMEMORATES
THE COURAGE AND SACRIFICE OF
POLISH SOLDIERS, PILOTS OF THE
AIRPLANE, WHO LOST THEIR LIVES
ON INDEPENDENCE DAY. 'ISKRA'
CRASHED IN SOPLICÓW, OTWOCK
ON 11TH NOVEMBER 1998.





GEOHERMAL BOREHOLE

IN OCTOBER 2023 LOCAL
AUTHORITIES OF OTWOCK HAVE
STARTED A PROCESS OF DRILLING
A WELL IN ORDER TO DETERMINE
GEOHERMAL WATER RESOURCES.





GUREWICZ'S GUESTHOUSE

THIS BUILDING IS THE LARGEST
WOODEN BUILDING IN
OTWOCK. ARCHITECTURE
RESEARCHERS OF THAT TIME
CLAIM THAT IT IS THE LARGEST
WOODEN BUILDING OF THIS
TYPE IN EUROPE. NOWADAYS, IT
IS A HOTEL, A RESTAURANT
AND A CAFE.





GRADUATION TOWER

IN THE MUNICIPAL PARK,
SITTING NEAR THE
GRADUATION TOWER, YOU CAN
INHALE AIR FULL OF HEALTHY
ELEMENTS.






SPA HOUSE (CURRENTLY A BUILDING OF A HIGH SCHOOL)

A FORMER SPA HOUSE, ESTABLISHED AT THE TURN OF THE 1920s AND 1930s WAS INITIALLY SUPPOSED TO HAVE A FUNCTION OF A GUEST HOUSE WITH A CASINO. THE BUILDING HAS GOT A PALACE LAYOUT WITH DECORATIVE STAIRS, FACADE, COLUMNS AND SCULPTURES.






CENTRE OF FOREST EDUCATION IN CELESTYNÓW

NEAR OTWOCK, IN
CELESTYNÓW, THERE IS A
CENTRE OF FOREST
EDUCATION, WHERE YOU CAN
LEARN ABOUT FAUNA AND
FLORA OF THE FORESTS IN
OTWOCK.





THE GEOPHYSICAL OBSERVATORY OFFICE BUILDING AND THE MEASUREMENT AREA

THE OBSERVATORY WAS ESTABLISHED
IN 1910 AND CURRENTLY IT IS
MONITORING SOME ATMOSPHERIC
PARAMETERS RELATED TO
METEOROLOGY, RADIOACTIVE AND
AEROSOL AIR POLLUTION AND
ATMOSPHERIC ELECTRICITY, WHICH IS
THE MAIN TASK FOR THE RESEARCH.

NUMEROUS MEASURING INSTRUMENTS

MAZOVIAN COMPLEX OF LANDSCAPE PARKS

MAZOVIAN LANDSCAPE PARK
WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1986. THE
AREA OF THE PARK IS 15.710 HA.

OVER 70% OF THE AREA IS
COVERED BY CONIFEROUS
FORESTS. A DOMINANT SPECIES
OF THE ANIMALS HERE IS A
MOOSE.
